These make you CuddlyCoo TeePee

- 1. TeePee Legs 12 nos (Each leg is made of 3 pieces one center piece and 2 side pieces)
- 2. Cotton Canvas Tent
- 3. String to hold the legs together.

Making your CuddlyCoo SAFE

- CuddlyCoo TeePee can be used for children between the age group of 1-10 years
- You can place a mat on the floor for added comfort.
- Ensure that the legs are properly assembled and the each pices is tightly screwed into the other
- Ensure that the string is properly looped into the holes on top ans securely fastened. It is this string that hold the legs together.

FAQs

1. How do I ensure that the legs are assembled correctly? Each Leg has 3 parts. The part with a hole on one end is the top end. the part with 2 screw heads is the middle part and the remaining part is the bottom part. Screw each into the other and the leg will be strong.

2. How do I ensure that the tent is stretched properly to form a square? Once the string is inserted into the holes as in part - 3 spread the bottom part of the tent. It should form a square. Now secure the string tightly.

3. Is there a risk of suffocation in the TeePee?
The TeePee has an open window which wil ensure that there is adequate airflow through the tent.

4. Can I use the TeePee for my littleone to sleep at night? No. The TeePee is Solely designed for play. It is not advised to use it as an alternate to bed.

5. Can I use the TeePee for Camping?
No. The TeePee is designed for playing Indoors. It isn't water proof or weather resistant which is essential for camping.

Part 1 - Assembling the TeePee Legs

Please consider the following before assembly. The TeePee has 4 legs. Each leg has 3 parts.

Top piece with a joint screw on one side and a hole on the other side Middle piece with joint caps on both side Bottom piece with a joint screw on one part

Screw together the 3 parts thus to form 4 legs of the TeePee.



Part 2 - Inserting the legs into the TeePee

The TeePee is broad on the lower side and narrow on the upper side. The narrow upper side has 4 pockets into which the 4 legs have to be inserted.

Hold the leg at an angle and open the pocket. Please ensure that the bottom part (without the hole) of the leg is inserted first.

Insert all 4 legs into 4 pockets of the TeePee. After insertion the upper part of the leg (with the hole) should stick out as shown.



Part 3 - Tying the Tee Pee

Pass the string through the hole in one of the legs - Then pass it through the loop hole provided on the upper edge of the TeePee - Then pass the string through the hole on the immediately next leg - Then through the loop hole on the next edge and so on.

Alternate between passing through one hole on the leg and then the loop hole and the next leg.

After passing it through the last loop hole, secure it tightly using a shoelace knot as shown. Be sure that the string is tight, as this holds the tent together.



Part 4 - Your Tent is now ready to use.

Once the string is tightly secured, spread the legs to form a roughly 3.5 feet square. base. Press on the top of the leg so that the base becomes wide enough.

Open the tent door and tie it up. Your Little one's tent is now ready to use!
